Risk is worked out using numbers 1 - 5. The likelihood is given a number and this is multiplied by the number given to the severity of the risk.

The result = the risk factor. This generic risk assessment is brief and we have our own individual assessments for each individual risk, 25 being the worst possible outcome, any item reaching 25 would give serious cause for concern & we would not be able to erect the unit. It is recommended that clients undertake their own risk assessment to suit their requirements. This is a generic risk assessment that only applies in normal conditions. Should there be any unexpected influencing factors, this risk assessment must be amended to suit. The provision of this risk assessment is intended as a guide only and cannot be used as a substitute for your own risk assessments being carried out.
